

The Rena Fucillo Trophy is presented annually to the high scoring member team(s) in a regular class at Charles River Dog Training Club's March Obedience Trial in memory of Rena Fucillo in grateful acknowledgement of her long association with the CRDTC as an inspiring teacher, dedicated trainer, and encouraging friend.

A qualifying score is required for all prizes and awards. An exhibitor whose dog wins an award must be present to accept the award when it is presented. In case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize. Prizes must be claimed on the day of the trial.

Obedience Classes

Regular Classes: Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

Optional Titling Classes: Beginner Novice A & B, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility

Alternative Titling Classes: Preferred Novice, Preferred Open, Preferred Utility

UDX and PUDX Classes: Dogs entered in these classes will be entered in both Open B and Utility B or in both Preferred Open and Preferred Utility. Once the limit has been reached in either Open B and Utility B or in either of Preferred Open and Preferred Utility, the UDX or the PUDX class will be considered closed. Any subsequent entries for these classes will not be accepted in their entirety. Entry fees must be paid for both classes.

Rally Classes

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Masters, Choice

RAE Class: Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B. Once the limit has been reached in either of these classes the RAE class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Entry fees must be paid for both classes. Exhibitors in the RAE class will receive a refund if one component of the class is unavailable.

RACH Class: Dogs entered in this class will be entered in three classes: Advanced B, Excellent B & Masters. Once the limit has been reached in any of these classes the RACH class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Entry fees must be paid for all classes. Exhibitors in the RACH class will receive a refund if any component of the class is unavailable.

Transfers (move-ups) for Rally Trial #2 are permitted if the Event Secretary is notified no later than 30 minutes before judging begins.

Scheduling

- Show hours are 8:00am-6:00pm.
- The Sunday Limited Obedience Trial runs in Ring 2 ahead of Rally Trial #2.
- Two Rally Trials are offered partially overlapping. Rally Trial #1 begins at 8:30am in Ring 1. Rally Trial #2 begins at 11am in Ring 2.
- Exhibitors should contact the Event Secretary (barb@paws4dogtrial.com) if they do not receive a copy of the Judging Schedule within two weeks of the closing date.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

Ring and Space Information

- Obedience and Rally Rings will be separated by a solid wall.
- Both rings are 40 x 50 feet.
- Indoor crating is very limited. There is no space for personal chairs. Please use space efficiently and stay clear of walking areas.

Directions and Parking

From I495: Take Exit 43 to Route 140S towards Franklin. Proceed south on Route 140 for approximately 1 mile. Take a right onto Fisher Street and proceed across the railroad tracks. MasterPeace Dog Training is the second building on the left – look for the large red sign.

Park within the lot adjacent to MasterPeace Dog Training or parallel along Fisher Street. Do not park in the Department of Public Works (DPW) Lot across the street. Do not relieve dogs in the DPW lot/yard.

Notes

- All classes with jumps will be judged in ascending height order.
- All breeds, including All American Dogs, will be shown in the same Obedience and Rally classes.
- The required \$4.50 AKC Service and Recording Fee is included in the entry fees listed above.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of exhibitor errors or cancellation after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, or excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it is incorrectly entered.
- Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, judges, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs and participants is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of the entry fee will be made.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, or email/text/messenger entries will not be accepted.
- Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms will not be accepted.
- The Club and its Event Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Event Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog twice or in a class for which the dog is ineligible to compete.
- Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequently returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. dollars. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- Females in season: A refund will be made for a bitch that comes into season after the Closing Date, provided that the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's note and is received by the Event Secretary prior to the start of judging.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
